

Notice to Exhibitors

Test/Trial location will be available from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm, or one hour after conclusion of event. No unentered dogs (except set-out dogs) are allowed at the test/trial site. Limited shade is available. Bring your own canopies. Bath/Cool off tub will be provided. Please bring your own chairs. Schedule will be provided. Bitches in season will be allowed but will be moved to the end of the class in **test** classes. Please notify the Test/Trial Secretary if your bitch is in season.

ALL AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB RULES REGARDING CONDUCT WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

No refund for duplicate entries or for any other cause beyond the control of the club after closing of entries.

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY. NO CONDITIONAL ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

ENTRY FORMS MUST BE SIGNED.

Any type of overnight mail must be marked "No signature required."

A separate entry blank for each class must be completed for each dog entered. If the dog is being entered in the identical class or classes for both Saturday and Sunday, you may simply check both boxes indicating the day entered. If your dog is entered in a different class each day, please fill out separate entry forms. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the 'Current' Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Forms are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Owners or their agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dog(s) at the test/trial arena. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. Exhibitors are expected to maintain the premises in a clean and tidy condition. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Test/Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or to complete the test/trial, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Children must be under the supervision of their parent or guardian at all times. Non-compliance with this rule will force the committee to ask them to leave the premises.

Exhibitors: Please Note

- ❖ The "A" course sheep (130ft x 215ft) and duck arenas (110ft x 110 ft) will be laid out as in the diagram in the Rules and Regulations.
- ❖ The "B" course outruns will be set at the minimums for both goats & ducks
- ❖ The "D" course will include a chute, sort, and gateway
- ❖ Exhibition-only entries will be accepted, entry fee \$25/run and can be accepted up 30 minutes prior to the start of trial the day of the trial provided the entry limit has not been reached.

There will not be any concessions offered at the trial. It will be necessary for exhibitors to bring their own food, water/beverages for themselves and dogs. Please practice appropriate 6 ft social distancing from other exhibitors.

Note: AKC's recent ruling effective September 3, 2013, the three qualifying scores required to be awarded a herding trial title may be earned under two or more different judges. The current Regulations require the three qualifying scores to be earned under three different judges. The effective date means that the second qualifying score under the same judge will only count if earned after September 3, 2013. The requirement of two passing legs earned under two different judges is still in effect for Herding Instinct Tests, Herding Tests and Pre-Trial Tests. This trial weekend will have the alternating test judges and trial judges for both BVKC and CDHA. If you are entering the test classes, be certain to enter under different judges

Livestock

Sheep – Dorper, Katahdin and Mixed breed sheep (value \$250 each) – Three to Five head of stock per run in A and B trial classes, Twenty head minimum of stock per run in C trial classes, and 10 – 15 head per run in D trial classes;

Goats – Registered Kiko and Crossbred Goats (value \$ 350 each) - three to five head of stock per run in B trial classes and 3 head per run in test classes. Note: PT **without** boundary will be run on three head of goats. PT **with** boundary will be run on a minimum of five head of goats.

Ducks - Mixed runner or call ducks (value \$50 each) Five head of stock per run.

Awarded to the dog who earns the highest combined weighted score compiled from Thursday PM (D course Sheep), Sun (A Sheep or Ducks, B Goats or Ducks, and C Goats) and Monday (A Sheep or Ducks, B Goats or Ducks, or C Goats). In calculating the winner of the High Combined Award, only qualifying scores count. A dog's three best scores from Thursday (Course D), Sunday (Course A,B, and/or C) and Monday (Course A, B, and/or C) will be added together. Each score must be from a different course OR stock (e.g., D Sheep, A Sheep, A Ducks, OR A Sheep, C Goats & B Goats, etc.). Scores used will be weighted by level (80% Started, 90% Intermediate, 100% Advanced).
